D—What did you DO in class?

Be specific and explain exactly what you did in detail. Don't be so specific that you give a minute by minute explanation, but make sure I know exactly what you did in class after I read your “D” paragraph.

L—What did you LEARN in class?

Explain exactly what you learned in class. Saying you know everything is not an option in the “L” paragraph. In every classroom, there is always an opportunity to learn...so tell me what you learned. How might you use the knowledge you learned in the future? Did your learning relate to something you have already learned in class?

I—What did you find INTERESTING?

What did you find interesting about class today? Was it a new concept or that something finally made sense? Did you learn something that is applicable to your world? Basically, what was it about today's lesson that you really thought was cool and interesting?

Q—What QUESTIONS do you have after today's lesson?

After today's lesson, what questions do you have about what you learned? Did everything make sense? Do you need clarification on a topic in order to understand? If you think you understood the lesson, write a level two and three question that push your thinking further.
